68% of people in jail have a substance use disorder.²

40% of people in the Dane County Jail live with mental illness.

80% of people in the Dane County Jail live with a substance use disorder.4

High Utilizers of Multiple Systems in Dane County

Dane County Data-Driven Justice — "Familiar Faces" Workgroup

335 people had 10+bookings between January 2015 and June 2018

322 people were familiar to the Dane County Department of Human Services

120 people were admitted/release by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections

264 people had a record of a diagnosis from a WellPath (CCS) Jail Health Provider

High Utilizers of Multiple Systems in Dane County

Dane County Data-Driven Justice — "Familiar Faces" Workgroup

11 people had 15+ bookings between January 2018 and August 2019

Combined, these 11 people spent 1,599 days in jail.

One individual had over 35 bookings in those 20 months.

Combined, these 11 people account for **\$479,145** (based on costs by DHS, DCSO, DOC, and MPD).
