



## Midtown Community Court

- Idea: Rethinking the judicial response to low level crimes and "quality of life" violations
- Location: A stand-alone building in Midtown,
  Manhattan; shared with an off-Broadway theater
- Jurisdiction: 3 police precincts (now 6), young adults (18-25) and mental health services boroughwide
- UpNext: Fatherhood and employment program
- New initiatives: Project Reset, Community First, harm reduction services







### Red Hook Community Justice Center

- Idea: Engaging a community that had no faith in the justice system or law enforcement
- Location: A Catholic school that had been vacant for two decades
- Jurisdiction: 3 police precincts; criminal, family, and housing
- Peacemaking program
- Housing Resource Center









## South Dallas Community Court (TX)

- Est. 2004
- 5 community courts in Dallas
- New Life Opportunity Initiative
- Reentry programming









## Orange County Community Court (CA)

- Est. 2008
- Community-based location
- Service providers are co-located
- Higher level charges are eligible











#### **Centre for Justice Innovation (UK)**

- Support evidence-based pretrial case disposals
- Community Advice program at courthouse in Islington, London
- Reform mapping
- Sentencing research



#### **Neighborhood Justice Center (AUS)**

- Links to life changing treatment and support services
- Work with residents and services to find practical, sustainable solutions to issues of crime and harm
- Community resource



### Social Services

- Community Court: 78%
- Traditional Court: 22%

- Jail Usage
  - Community Court: 1%
  - Traditional Court: 36%
- Decreased recidivism
- Decreased justice spending
