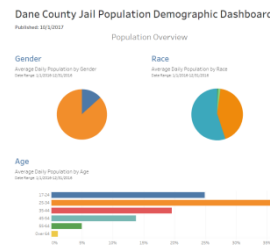


Jail Population Demographics

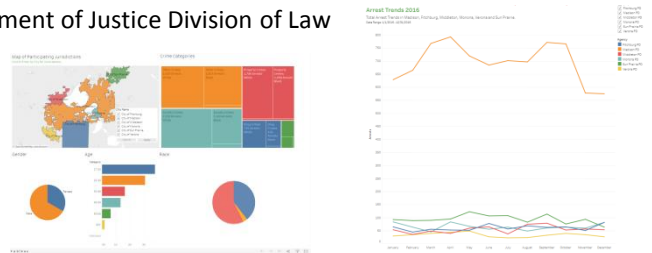


Arrests Dashboard & Arrest Trend line Dashboard

2016 Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Data



Data Notes and Disclaimers:

1. Data based on adult and juvenile arrests reported by Wisconsin law enforcement agencies to the Wisconsin Department of Justice under the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) program.
2. Arrests in the UCR program are defined as: All persons processed by arrest (booking), citation, or summons (when served by an officer) for committing an offense in its jurisdiction.
3. Arrest counts are based on the most serious charge reported to the UCR program, rather than the number of charges.
4. Juvenile arrests include juveniles who are detained, advised along with a parent of the charge and arrest, and released to the parent. *
5. Runaways are excluded from this report. The original definition of runaway under UCR was not a criminal offense, but was collected as part of the arrest data for juveniles. At the federal level since 2009, runaways were no longer required as a separate category for juvenile arrests and it was officially removed from WI reporting in 2016.

7. This report contains data collected through the Wisconsin Summary-Based (SBR) and Incident-Based Reporting (IBR) UCR programs. Data from the IBR program have been converted to an SBR format following the FBI's conversion rules.

* The Dane County CJC Website features data pertaining to adults, defined by [Wisconsin Statute 990.01\(3\)](#) as a person who has attained the age of 17 years.

Crime Categories

Violent Crimes: Aggravated Assault, Murder & Nonnegligent Manslaughter, Rape, Robbery

Society Crimes: Curfew/Loitering Violations, Disorderly Conduct, Driving Under the Influence, Gambling, Liquor Laws, Prostitution & Commercialized Vice, Sex Offenses, Vagrancy Violations, Weapons

Property Crimes: Arson, Burglary, Embezzlement, Forgery & Counterfeiting, Fraud, Larceny Theft, Motor Vehicle Theft, Stolen Property, Vandalism

Drug Crimes: Drug – Unknown; Possession - Marijuana, Opium/Cocaine, Other Dangerous, Synthetic; Drug Sale - Marijuana, Opium/Cocaine, Other Dangerous, Synthetic

Other Crimes: All Other Offenses, Manslaughter by Negligence, Offenses Against Family and Children, Simple Assault
