#### 1. Initial Discussion on Intercept 3: Jails/Courts

Presentation by Clark-Bernhardt.

Review of Sequential Intercept Model (SIM) mapping report, completed by Policy Research Associates in 2018. Progression to Intercept 3.

Motion for a brief recess due to technical issues by Triggs, seconded by Shimko. Meeting recessed at 12:38pm; resumed at 12:45pm.

Discussion ensues about current mental health practices, screening, treatment, and support in the Dane County Jail. There is still a long wait for an open mental health bed. Data on mental illness has improved since the 2018 report. Discussion of reentry services for people with planned release times. Discussion of competency assessment, restoration, and timeline. There are people who have multiple cases with multiple competency hearings over time, without maintaining competency. Discussion of challenges with transport to Winnebago for in-patient mental health services.

Committee members should review report to determine if prior recommendations are still pertinent and whether the gaps identified in the report remain problems.
