# **STEP 1**

Process Kick-Off and Preparation



Convene stakeholders to engage in shared learning and discuss state of project

> Obtain answers to technical data questions

Develop initial memorandum of understanding (MOU) for exploratory data linking

# **STEP 2**

Determining Technical Feasibility



Begin initial data sharing with CJC analyst

Perform cross-agency data linking and analysis

Identify database gaps and needs

### **STEP 3**

Sharing Early Findings and Solutions



Share feasibility findings with CJC

Provide recommendations for addressing gaps and making improvements

Brainstorm with CJC on next steps

#### **Next Steps:**

- Identify key questions (e.g., percentages of citizens arrested and booked into jail according to race/ethnicity, number of
  offenders served by diversion programs who have experienced no subsequent arrests, number of citizens with jobs after
  release from jail)
- Establish MOU for next phase
- Create work plan through 2018
