

Strategy 2: Pretrial Assessment


In April 2017, Dane County began using the PSA (Public Safety Assessment) at initial appearance. The PSA provides information that is race- and genderneutral. It helps guide pretrial decision making in an effort to increase safety, reduce taxpayer costs, and enhance fairness and efficiency in the system.

Strategy 3: Data Driven Justice


